# The compliance role of governing bodies

#### Ensure, by seeking assurance that:

- regulated activity is understood;
- schools undertake checks on those who work with children;
- At least one person on every recruitment panel has undergone safer recruitment training



## Regulated Activity



Regulated activity in relation to children: scope

**Factual note by HM Government** 

- Published 2012
- Definition and application



#### Pre-appointment checks

- Verify Identity
- Enhanced DBS (including Barred List check where appropriate)
- Verify candidates mental and physical fitness to carry out work responsibilities
- Verify Right to Work
- Overseas checks
- Qualifications (where approp.)



#### References

- Always in writing
- Scrutinised for contradiction & completeness
- Always from current employer
- Objective and factual to support appointment
- Good practice to sign and date when checked

#### Safer Recruitment Training

- Mandatory under Regulation 9, The School Staffing (England) Regulations 2009.
- To equip those interviewing with appropriate knowledge
- Various proprietary packages available
- Governing bodies should ensure it informs practice
